KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner/ plaintiff seeking directions to the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Kaithal to decide Civil Suit No. 411 of 2019 titled as Arun Kumar & Ors. Vs. Inder Singh & Ors., in a time bound manner.

2. The counsel for the petitioner in support of the present petition has, *inter alia*, contended that the aforesaid civil suit was filed by the petitioner and proforma respondents herein, in February, 2019 and is still at the stage of plaintiffs' evidence. That the plaintiffs have already examined three witnesses. It is further submitted that the trial Court be given directions to decide the civil suit in a time bound manner.

3. I have considered the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

4. Recently the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Shaikh Uzma Feroz Hussain Vs. State of Maharashtra**, Writ Petition (Crl.) No. 587 of 2023, decided on 10.11.2023 has observed that the Constitutional Courts should

avoid temptation of fixing a time bound schedule for disposal of any case before any Court unless the situation is extra ordinary.

5. In the instant case, the counsel for the petitioner has failed to establish that the case at hand is an exceptional case. So, no ground is made out to issue any such direction to make its disposal a time bound. However, taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, the learned trial Court is directed to make sincere efforts to dispose of the civil suit in an expeditious manner without granting unnecessary adjournments.

6. The revision petition stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.
