VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have assailed the judgment dated 07.07.2018 passed by the learned Family Court, Gurugram vide which their application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties in terms of Settlement Agreement dated 04.07.2023. Copy of the Settlement Agreement and the affidavit of the petitioner dated 08.08.2023 has been placed on record. It has been further submitted that the respondent shall pay a sum of Rs. 28 Lakhs on account of permanent alimony to petitioner No.1. Furthermore, they have instituted a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act. A sum of Rs.14 Lakhs on account of permanent alimony has already been paid and the balance amount of Rs. 14 Lakhs is to be paid when the statements of the parties at the stage of 2nd motion shall be recorded.

3. Learned counsel further submits that as an amicable settlement has been effected between the parties, he has instructions to withdraw the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
