DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

Petitioner is seeking regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.37 dated 22.03.2022 registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur under Sections 302 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Petitioner is wife of brother-in-law (saala) of deceased Sunny. Marriage of deceased Sunny and Beena was performed in the year 2009. Two childrens were born out of this marriage. Petitioner was married to brother-in-law of the deceased in the year 2016.

It is alleged that on the date of incident deceased had gone to the place of his in-laws where his wife Beena on the asking of her family members mixed some poisonous substance and made it to be consumed by the deceased on account of which he expired.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out towards the

Medical Report (Annexure P-2) revealing that the suspected poisonous substance was 2 tablets of sulphas which having pungent smell so, it is not possible that despite the deceased seeing the petitioner and others mixing the said substance that he will consume the same. The story appears to be quite unnatural.

As per the custody certificate petitioner has already undergone 7 months 18 days of custody. Out of 21 witnesses none has been examined so far. Trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to all the facts and circumstances as noticed above, I find it fit case to grant bail to the petitioner. As such, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Sangrur.
