Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to grant the scale of Rs.5200-20200 + GP Rs.2400/- to the petitioners w.e.f. 01.01.2018, which is being granted to other multipurpose health workers (female) ANMS, working in the State Health Mission along with the petitioner, and all arrears be released to the petitioners with market rate interest.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per instructions received by him, petitioner has been granted all the benefits claimed in the petition. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
