1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking setting aside of impugned order dated 18.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 - the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court-I, Faridabad, whereby the application was decided against the petitioner-Firm. A further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to direct respondent No.1 to join the services of petitioner-Firm within the stipulated time.

2. A perusal of file reveals that when the matter was taken up for hearing on 30.05.2022, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per office report, notice could not be issued to the respondents for want of process fee.

Let fresh notice be issued to the respondents for 01.02.2023, on furnishing of process fee by the counsel for

the petitioner within a period of four weeks from today.

Interim order to continue.”

3. As per Office Report, learned counsel for the petitioner has still not filed the process fee, therefore, notice to the respondents could not be issued.

4. Today, no one has appeared to represent the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
