Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner since May, 2020 to till date along with interest @ 24% per annum.

Affidavit of Dr. Sandeep Batish, Deputy Civil Surgeon, Kaithal has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

By referring to para 7 of the affidavit, State counsel submits that the entire arrears of salary due to the petitioner upto January, 2023 have been released.

In view of the above, writ petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.
