The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.86 dated 27.12.2011 under Sections 420, 34 IPC registered at PS Shahpur Kandi, District Gurdaspur (now Pathankot).

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner nor has any request for a pass over been made.

The Counsel for the State submits that the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender on 17.10.2020. The Trial has proceeded against the co-accused and as many as 03 out of 07 witnesses have been examined till date.

In view of the above, at this stage of the Trial no case for quashing of the FIR is made out specially on behalf of an absconding accused. Therefore, the present petition stands dismissed.
