NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.43 dated 09.02.2018 under Sections 420, 447, 511, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 15.02.2020 (Annexure P-6).

2. In pursuance to the order of this Court dated 20.01.2023, a report dated 01.04.2023 has been received from the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana. The relevant portion of the said report is reproduced as under:-

“ As per the directions of Hon'ble High Court, complainant Pammi Sidhu appeared before the court and she stated that she is the complainant of the present case and present case has been registered against accused Harish Passi, Manohar Lal Passi, Vinay Passi @ Vinay Rani and Tripan Passi on her complaint. She stated that no compromise has been effected between her and accused persons and accused persons

had tortured her son Udhaybir Sidhu and also gave brutal beatings to them and under threat of life they got her signatures on the compromise deed. She stated that she want to pursue the present case and she requested to dismiss the quashing petition.”

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
