Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take decision and pass speaking order on the representations dated 10.12.2020, 11.12.2020, 14.07.2021 and 13.01.2022, Annexures P-13, P-14, P-15 and P-18, respectively, in view of order dated 27.07.2021, Annexure P-16, passed by this Court and personal hearing provided on 23.08.2021, Annexure P-17, before initiating any disciplinary action against the petitioner.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of the instant petition, charge-sheet has been issued against the petitioner under the Haryana Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 2016. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to take up all the pleas before the disciplinary authority.
