Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.139, dated 11.09.2022, registered at Police Station South Sector 34, Chandigarh, under Sections 379A/34 and 411 IPC.

As per custody certificate placed on record, petitioner is in custody for the last four months and three days.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused Virender snatched the mobile phone from complainant-Pankaj Kashyap on 11.09.2022. The snatched mobile was recovered from the petitioner and the co-accused had grabbed the cycle of the complainant. Co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail by this Court, vide order dated 05.01.2023 passed in CRM-M-52524-2022.

Custody certificate further reveals that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Heard.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Area Magistrate.

Petitioner is disposed of accordingly.
