The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs.4,04,235/- including security qua the work of construction of various link roads under DMF Scheme (providing and laying tack coat, premix carpet, seal coat etc.) executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% p.a.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had executed various works assigned to him from time to time and there has never been any complaint against the works executed by the petitioner. On 19.05.2021, the abovesaid work was allotted to the petitioner vide EE No.639 dated 19.05.2021 and has been successfully completed on 27.09.2021. The payment of three running bills has already been made to the petitioner; but the payment of fourth and final running bill amounting to Rs.2,20,074/- and

security amount of Rs.1,84,161/- i.e. total amount of Rs.4,04,235/- has not been released till date. The petitioner approached the respondents for a number of times, but nothing fruitful could be fetched. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted numerous representations followed by a legal notice dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) upon the respondents but the respondents neither responded to the same nor did they make the payment of outstanding amount to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.5- The Executive Engineer, Construction Division No.1, PWD B&R Branch, Hoshiarpur is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.

Learned State Counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said representation, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in his favour within a further period of three months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
