The petitioners had filed the instant petition before this Court for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondent from harassing or interfering in the peaceful lives of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No.1 is major and is more than 18 years of age. She is living with petitioner No.2 at his house. Respondent No.4, who is father of the petitioner No.2 and has close links with the political leaders and the local police authorities, is threatening to eliminate the petitioners.

A short reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel submits that the police had recorded the statements of Paramjeet Singh and Sandeep Kaur, the parents of petitioner

No.1. Both of them stated that they did not want any action taken against the petitioners.

Learned State counsel further submits that there is no danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the family members of the petitioners, as revealed during the course of enquiry. The police has thoroughly investigated the matter and found that there is no threat to both the petitioners.

In view of the statements made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the petition is disposed off accordingly.
