Aditya Birla Finance Limited has filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing the District Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali to exercise power vested under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (hereinafter to be referred to 'the 2002 Act') and thereby to facilitate the taking over as also handing of the actual physical possession of the Secured Asset in question.
