Prayer made in the present writ petition is to restrain the respondents from forcibly evicting the petitioner without following the due process of law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner fairly concedes that the petitioner had been granted license to run a Tea stall/booth adjacent to the Library Hall for the facility of students studying overnight. It is also not in dispute that after the expiry of the initial contract period, even the period of extension granted to the petitioner came to an end on 31.08.2023.

It is also not the case of the petitioner that the respondents have made any arbitrary allotment in favour of any third party to run a Tea Stall at the premises in dispute.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of

the present writ petition so as to pursue his alternative remedies with the respondent authorities for the above said relief.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
