The petitioner herein has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking to challenge his order of termination dated 18.10.2022, Annexure P-9, with an alternate prayer that the statutory appeal that has been filed against the order of termination be decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
