Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.0247 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 323, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed by this Court whereby the interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation.

Today, counsel for the petitioner apprised the Court that pursuant to the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that only simple injuries are attributed to the petitioner who got effected recovery of wooden stick and is not required by the police for

further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
