Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 670 days in filing the criminal revision petition.

Notice of the application was issued on 14.03.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he does not wish to file reply to the same and raises no objection to the application.

In view of the above, having gone through the contents of the application, sufficient cause has been made out for the purpose of condoning the delay of 670 days in filing the criminal revision petition. Accordingly, delay of 670 days in filing the criminal revision petition is condoned.

Main case

1. By way of present revision petition, challenge has been laid to an order dated 21.09.2016 passed by the Court of Additional Sessions

Judge, Fazilka, ordering the release of currency notes worth Rs.43 lacs to one Rupinder Singh @ Nikka, who happened to be one of the accused in FIR No.105, dated 24.09.2014, registered under Sections 408, 409, 380 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Fazilka.

2. Today, it has been informed that similar order was assailed at the instance of complainant-company before this Court by way of CRM-M-43464-2016, titled as “ISS SDB Security Services Pvt. Ltd. vs. State of Punjab and another”, which came to be decided vide order dated 04.10.2017, wherein, the aforesaid order dated 21.09.2016 was quashed and set aside.

3. In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the present revision petition. Disposed of accordingly.
