The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.157 dated 19.11.2022 registered with Police Station Goraya, Distt. Jalandhar, under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals Regulation Act, 2014.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 23.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 23.12.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 23.12.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
