1. Learned counsel submits that the statement made before the Division Bench, on the basis whereof the PIL was disposed of, has not been complied with.
2. It is not possible to take a view in contempt petition that there is a deliberate and willful attempt to flout the Court’s order as there is obviously no positive order passed by the Court.
3. Dismissed.
4. However, it does not come in the way of the petitioner to avail the remedies available to him in law.
