The petitioner is seeking interim bail for a period for four weeks on account of serious medical condition of his father.

Status report submitted by the learned State counsel indicates that though the father of the petitioner was admitted in Dayanand Medical College & Hospital, Ludhiana, but his elder brother, other family members and close relatives are also available to take care of the father of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the father of the petitioner has been discharged from the Hospital and presently in the house situated at village Sitto Naubad, P.S.Sadar Patti, Tarn Taran. He further submits that the condition of the father of the petitioner is still critical and is to be shifted again to the Hospital in a short period of time. He restricts his prayer only to the extent that appropriate directions may be issued to facilitate the presence of the petitioner at his parental house to meet his father for some period of time. The petitioner is stated to be confined in Central Jail, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the limited prayer is granted to the petitioner.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar, to make necessary arraignments to facilitate the presence of the petitioner in his parental house on 27.01.2023 from 11:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. to facilitate the meeting of the petitioner with his ailing father while in custody and under proper security.
