On 22.12.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a complaint case No.COMA-39 of 2022 dated 07.01.2022 under Section 115 read with Section 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (D&R) Act, 1957, registered by State through Mining Officer, case titled as ‘State Through Mining Officer Vs. M/s. JRB Buildcon Pvt. Ltd. Through Arvind Kumar (Annexure P-1) pending before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panchkula.

The Counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that for certain unforeseen reasons, the petitioner could not appear on 21.10.2022. She submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 01.03.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Senior Citizen Home, Udyog

Path, Sector 15-D, Chandigarh. On his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner (or someone on his behalf) shall prepare an FDR in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and deposit the same with the Trial Court. The same would be liable to be forfeited as per law in case of the absence of the petitioner from Trial without sufficient cause in future.

In furtherance of the aforementioned order the petitioner surrendered on 31.01.2023 and has since been admitted to bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall keep on appearing before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself but for sufficient cause.
