The petitioner through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is seeking directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to look into representation dated 18.07.2022 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia* submits that petitioner had made representation dated 18.07.2022 against respondent No.4 to 7, however, police authorities are not looking into the matter.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Dimple Jain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court on advance notice, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and assures the Court that police authority would look into the matter and redress the grievance of the petitioner.

In view of statement of learned State counsel, this Court is sanguine of the fact that police authorities would look into the matter in

accordance with law and redress the grievance of the petitioner expeditiously and preferably within three months. No further order is warranted.
