KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case having FIR No. 157 dated 10.11.2020, registered under Sections 408 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Bajghera, District Gurugram, to which Sections 467 and 471 IPC were added lateron.

The allegations in nutshell are that Ranvijay Singh son of the petitioner was working in the complainant Company and he embezzled huge amount from the accounts of the said Company and thereafter he transferred the said amount to different persons including the present petitioner. Ranvijay Singh has been arrested in this case.

On the last date of hearing, a detailed order was passed by this Court whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation with the police.

Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel, on instructions from SI Sanjiv Kumar, apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and now the petitioner is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police.

In the light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the instant petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.12.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
