Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of impugned order dated 05.03.2018 (P-4), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram, whereby petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person in a Complaint No.138/NI/4329/2015 dated 06.04.2015 (P-1), under Sections 138, 141, 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 read with Sections 420, 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and for quashing of FIR No.821 dated 11.10.2018, under Section 174-A, IPC, registered at Police Station Shivaji Nagar, District Gurugram along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 09.12.2018 (P-5) arrived at between the parties.
