On asking of the Court, Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

According to petitioner, he filed a complaint under Section 138 of NI Act against the husband of respondent No.6, which is pending. As a counter blast, respondent No.6 i.e. wife of the complainant has lodged a false complaint in order to harass the petitioner. He made the representation Annexure P.7 to the authorities but no action has been taken so far.

This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to look into the matter and decide the representation dated 07.07.2022 (Annexure P.7) within a period of one month. In case, petitioner is still aggrieved, he may approach this Court again.
