Vide order dated 15.07.2022 bail granted to the petitioner has been cancelled and his bail bonds have been forfeited to the State for non-appearance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on the last date of hearing as he was suffering from depression on account of death of his brother. On all other dates he has been present and has never absented from the trial, thus, the impugned order may be quashed.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to file reply.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 27.01.2023 and seek regular bail. In case such an application is filed, the same shall be allowed.
