1. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner had applied for grant of sports gradation certificate vide representation dated 04.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) but the said representation is still pending consideration with the respondent and non grant of the gradation certificate is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Hence, the respondent be directed to take appropriate decision on the application seeking the gradation certificate.

3. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case the representation dated 04.10.2023 (Annexure P-2), by which the petitioner is seeking the grant of gradation certificate, has not been decided so far, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of 4 weeks of the receipt of the copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled for any gradation certificate, the same will be issued failing which, due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order itself.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
