This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to challenge the order dated 11.10.2022 (Annexure P-3), whereby appeal moved by the petitioner against the order dated 16.07.2021 passed under The Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 was dismissed.

As per averments, senior citizen executed two sale deeds dated 09.03.2016 and 04.04.2016 respectively in favour of his two sons, namely, Satbir Singh and Ramotar and later senior citizen sought cancellation of these instruments by invoking the provisions of The Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. The claim of the senior citizen was dismissed by Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Maintenance Tribunal, Rewari vide order dated 16.07.2021 and the said decision was further upheld by the appellate authority through impugned decision dated 11.10.2022.

Mr. Nipun Vashisht, Advocate states that during the pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has expired.

Considering the nature of claim by the senior citizen, nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.
