The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondent No.1- Bar Council of India to add and include the degree of the petitioner in the list of qualified law decrees of Bar Council of India and also to convey the same to National Committee on Accreditation (NCA) Canada, Federation of Law Societies Canada.

Learned counsel for respondent No.1- Bar Council of India contends that the respondent-University had not deposited the mandatory fee, as a result whereof the name of the said University had been deleted. He, however, further contends that now the requisite fee has already been deposited

by the respondent-University and that the website of the Bar Council of India shall be updated preferably within a period of four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the same.
