This petition though has been preferred by the petitioner in person under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 26.10.2023 (Annexure P-1), moved by the petitioner to transfer him from Mahendergarh to Sirsa, on account of suffering from Asthma and Sinus, as has been stated in para 4 of the instant petition.

“4. That the petitioner made a representation to respondent no.1 & 2 to transfer him from S/urban S/Divn. Mohendergarh to Sirsa due to illness of Asthma & Sinus.”

Having gone through the writ petition and the contents of the representation dated 26.10.2023, which is addressed to the Chief Engineer (HR & Admn.), DHBVN, Hisar, on account of medical ailment of the petitioner for transferring him from Mahendergarh to Sirsa, since his condition was deteriorated after his transfer at Mahendergarh, who is resident of H.No.87, near Bank of Baroda, Sirsa.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the representation dated 26.10.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within a period of one week from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
