In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though, she has approached the respondent-Sports and Youth Affairs Department, Haryana for the issuance of sports gradation certificate but the same is not being granted to her due to which, a prejudice is being caused to the petitioner as the petitioner, who is competing for the group-D post is feeling handicap in the absence of gradation certificate.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the only prayer of the petitioner is that respondents be directed to decide the representation dated 06.01.2023 (Annexure P/8), which has been submitted by her with the respondents for the grant of sports gradation certificate.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case any representation has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with

the respondents, the same will be processed and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for the relief, the same will be extended to her within a period of further 02 weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
