Prayer in this application is for addition of offences under Sections 326 and 450 IPC and for removal of Section 452 IPC in case FIR No. 71 dated 22.08.2015 as the same have been inadvertently mentioned in this petition.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and offence under Sections 326 and 450 IPC are ordered to be added in this petition and Section 452 IPC is ordered to be removed.

Requisite corrections be made.

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'the Cr.P.C'), is for quashing of FIR No.71 dated 22.08.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 450 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code,

1860, registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa (Annexure P-1), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

In view of the statement given by the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
