Petitioner-wife has filed this writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the report dated 09.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) submitted by SHO WPS, Chandigarh, which has been accepted by the higher authorities and further for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to register an FIR against petitioner's husband for alleged commission of offence punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, etc.

During the course of hearing, when learned counsel for the petitioner is confronted with the maintainability of the writ petition, as the petitioner can avail the alternative remedy, Mr. Ahluwalia, learned counsel does not press this writ petition and prays for withdrawal of the same, in order to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
