Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to remove the illegal construction of respondent No.5 beyond permissible limits near the ammunition dump of Army endanger the life of petitioner and others and to take further action on the order dated 08.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed and presented the same in Contempt Petition observed in order dated 22.03.2022 (Annexure P-5) and by which respondent No.2 directed respondent No.4 to proceed further as per law which is still lying with respondent No.4 illegally, arbitrary and erroneously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is apparent that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court on the earlier occasion, the speaking order has been passed and the Municipal Corporation, Pathankot has been directed to take the necessary action. He further

submits that the Contempt Petition was also filed wherein the respondents have submitted on affidavit that illegal construction would be demolished and the SHO has also been informed about the same.

Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of the above position, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to pursue the alternative remedies as available to him in accordance with law as the order has already been passed in view of the undertaking given by the respondents before the Contempt Court as well.
