SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought issuance of direction to official respondents No.1 to 4 to initiate appropriate legal action by registering FIR against private respondents and erring revenue officials, who in connivance with each other have committed fraud and cheated the petitioner by executing sale deeds of his land.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had purchased 4.75 marla land in the year 2021 vide registered sale deed, Annexure P2 and an entry was made in the revenue record in his favour. He submits that by transfer deed dated 06.06.2023, Annexure P4, this piece of land has been illegally transferred by private respondent No.6 to his son – respondent No.7 with an intention to defraud the petitioner. He

submits that the petitioner has submitted representations, Annexures P5 to P7 to the authorities, but no action is being taken.

3. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to look into the representation, Annexure P7.

4. Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr.Arun Luthra, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it appropriate to await response from the respondents.

7. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the allegations, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 - Deputy Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar to examine the representation, Annexure P7, within a period of two months and to take appropriate action, if warranted, in accordance with law.
