The present third petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim regular bail on medical grounds to the petitioner in case FIR No.130 dated 05.05.2023 registered under Sections 22/25/29 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station STF, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

On 20.11.2023, the State was directed to verify the factum of kidney problem of the petitioner and to file status report. Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Vavinder Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Task Force, Border Range, District Amritsar, along with report of the petitioner issued by Medical Officer, Central Jail, Amritsar is also attached as Annexure R-1. Status report is taken on record. The said report shows that the petitioner, in fact, is suffering from kidney problem. However, as per the doctors he is able to manage the problem by conservative treatment and oral medication. At one

point of time when the petitioner was admitted in Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar, the doctor advised him haemodialysis. However, he refused to undergo the said process. Not only that, when second time, the petitioner was referred to the Guru Nanak Dev Hospital, Amritsar, he even refused to go to the said hospital.

In view of the above, it is clear that the petitioner is less interested in getting treatment for his problem, more interested in coming out of the jail. Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to grant him interim regular bail on medical ground.

Dismissed.
