1. For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and delay of 716 days in filing of the appeal is condoned.

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2. The instant appeal, under Clause X of the Letters Patent Appeal, is against the judgment/order dated 21.02.2018 passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court, whereby petition (CWP-11107-1992) filed by petitioner-appellant seeking the benefit of counting *ad hoc* service towards seniority, has been dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant has not been able to cite any judgment/case law to show that the *ad hoc* service can be counted towards the seniority. Hence, no ground is made out to interfere in the

judgment/order passed by the learned Single Judge.

4. Resultantly, finding no merits, present appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main appeal has been dismissed, all pending misc. application(s) stand disposed of.
