This is a second petition petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.484 dated 14.09.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 302, 506, 201, 212, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Tauru, District Nuh (Haryana).
