The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.79 dated 30.9.2022 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act (added later on) at Police Station, Sadar Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

By virtue of the order dated 23.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 23.12.2022 petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. It is further submitted that petitioner has also handed over demand draft of Rs.7,000/- to the complainant as directed by this court.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that petitioner has joined investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further

investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 23.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
