The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.175 dated 10.10.2022 registered under Sections 307, 452, 336 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (from which Section 307 of the IPC was deleted later on) at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in compliance with order dated 23.12.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.12.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
