Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.,
praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case bearing FIR
No. 151 dated 29.10.2022 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of the
Indian Penal Code at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 06.07.2023 passed by this Court, *ad interim*
anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1
is mother and petitioner No.2 is wife, of main-accused Rajpal Singh
(petitioner in CRM-M-7356-2023). Mr. H.S. Deol, Advocate, representing
Rajpal Singh, undertakes to clear the dues of complainant- Rajinder Singh son
of Manjit Singh.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.07.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
