This is an application filed under Section 151 CPC for placing on record the office order bearing No.626 dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure R-2/1).

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the chargesheet dated 06.04.2015 (Annexure P-3), inquiry report dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) and impugned order dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure

P-9/T), being illegal, arbitrary, without basis and contrary to the provisions of relevant law and against the principle of natural justice.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed vide order dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure R-2/1) whereby chargesheet dated 06.04.2015, inquiry report dated 08.12.2015 (Annexure P-6) and impugned order dated 17.05.2017 (Annexure P-9/T) have been ordered to be dropped and recovery has been waived off. He further submits that the present writ petition has thus rendered infructuous.

In view of the order dated 26.08.2021 (Annexure R-2/1), the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed and nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present case, the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
