The petitioner claiming to be physically handicapped employee prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to consider posting her near, her place of residence.

Yesterday, the case came up for the urgent motion hearing.

Sh. Charanpreet Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, was requested to take instructions in this regard from the concerned department. He has informed the Court that at present both the stations for posting as identified by the petitioner are not available as the head teachers have already been posted in both the stations.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the respondent-State be directed to identify any other vacant place of posting to accommodate the petitioner keeping in mind her disability.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation in this regard in the concerned department, which shall be sympathetically considered.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
