The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation of the case bearing FIR No.56 dated 06.09.2022 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act 2014 pertaining to Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3 – SSP, Kapurthala to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioner with respect to the threats being extended to him by the accused party in FIR No.56 dated 06.09.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-2).
