This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned notice dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that by virtue of letter dated 27.10.2022, the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Samrala had directed the petitioner to submit the record of the Gram Panchayat from the year 2013 to 2018 with respect to grants received by Village Gonsla, Tehsil Samrala during the period 2013-18, grant received for the cleaning of pond with copies of proposals approved for its use, record regarding expenditure of the grants received under MNREGA Scheme from the Central Government and action taken on the application

given to Smt. Bhupinder Kaur, BDPO, Samrala by complainant Doctor Jasdev Singh son of Pragat Singh resident of Village Gosla. It is further submitted that the said record is not available with the present petitioner and thus, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file reply to the said letter issued by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Samrala.

In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file reply to the said letter. The said reply be filed within a period of two weeks from today. The respondents including the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Samrala would thereafter proceed in the matter, in accordance with law.

It is made clear that this Court has not gone into the merits of the contentions raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner and the present order should not be construed so as to restrain the respondents from proceeding in the matter, in accordance with law.
