LISA GILL, J.

Grievance raised in this writ petition is that earlier Ward No.6 was reserved for the scheduled caste category and thereafter in an illegal and unjustified manner, it is Ward No.5 which is being reserved for scheduled caste and not Ward No.6.

Learned counsel for the State to whom advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied, submits that without going into the aspect of maintainability of the writ petition, the same has however been rendered infructuous for the reason that Ward No.6 continues to be reserved for the scheduled caste category. Reference is made to final notification dated 06.09.2022 and the notification dated 21.10.2022, which indicates the same. Copies of the said notifications are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Despite the matter being called twice, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. However, keeping in view the fact that Ward No.6 continues to be reserved for the scheduled caste category, we find no

justification in keeping the matter pending. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say liberty is afforded to the petitioner to file appropriate application within two weeks from today in case any incorrect fact has been pleaded before us.
