Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.144 dated 3.12.2022 registered under Sections 306, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that there was some dispute between the husband and the wife on 28.11.2022 and on the same day, in the evening, petitioner No.1 wife of deceased Jasvir Singh was taken away from her matrimonial home by her brother-petitioner No.2 and then they went to parental house of petitioner No.1 and on the next day, Jasvir Singh committed suicide and at that time, the petitioners were not present in the house of the deceased. He further submits that FIR in this case was registered on the 4th day of the occurrence. He further submits that now the complainant (mother of the deceased) has given affidavit dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) in favour of the petitioners wherein she stated

that FIR was got registered due to some misunderstanding. He further

submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Najjar Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police and are not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation and has not further disputed affidavit (Annexure P-2) submitted by the complainant in favour of the accused persons including the petitioners.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 4.1.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
