Petitioner is seeking to set aside the order dated 02.12.2019 vide which the bail has been cancelled, bail bonds and personal bonds of the petitioner have also been cancelled and forfeited to the State and he has been summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that at the earlier instance, the petitioner was granted pre-arrest bail in terms of order dated 09.10.2018 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge. The petitioner had absented from the proceedings on 02.12.2019 on account of illness. Subsequently, he could not put appearance on account of Covid-19 Pandemic and death of his brother. The next date of hearing in the trial Court is stated to be on 20.01.2023. He restricts his prayer only to the extent that the petitioner will surrender in the trial Court within a period of 07 days and an appropriate direction may be issued for expeditious disposal of the bail application that may be moved by him and the present petition be dismissed as withdrawn.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that in the event, the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court within a period of 07

days, learned trial Court will look into the feasibility of expeditious disposal of the case in accordance with law and fact and circumstances of the case.
