Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the confidential report (adverse remarks) dated 17.09.2020 (Annexure P-1), order dated 17.12.2020 (Annexure P-2), order dated 25.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) and order dated 21.01.2022 (Annexure P-4).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently certain orders, which are required to be challenged, have not been challenged, thus, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making appropriate prayers and after giving full and better particulars.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
4. It is made clear that in case any such petition is filed by the petitioner, all issues including the issue of delay and maintainability would be considered independently in accordance with law.
