[1] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that she does not press the instant petition and would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana to consider and decide the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in a time bound manner in view of the petitioner's father being very sick.
